

Launch of the Global Talent Organizations Initiative

Paris, November 2019

On November 13, our project lead Dr. Martin Geiger and our main research partners from the Center for China and Globalization (CCG) in Beijing launched the 'Global Talent Organizations Initiative' at the second Paris Peace Forum. Our existing Canada-China partnered research project on global talent mobility is the pilot project of this initiative.



The research conducted through this unique global partnership will provide useful insights to the 'Global Talent Organizations Initiative' which is set to officially launch in June 2020. The initiative is working towards better governance of global talent that equally shares the benefits of migration while avoiding negative outcomes. In a shifting world order, this research is highly relevant to the challenges of increasing competition in the global race for talent.
